NDCDE is Hiring

NDCDE is growing its curriculum, evaluation, and learning management system (LMS) team. We have three new positions to help support this work. Visit https://www.cde.nd.gov/about-us/careers to learn more.

LMS Technical Support Specialist

(.8FTE): Provides a broad range of support services related to the digital curriculum, the LMS, and all technology used to deliver courses and related educational services. Closes 5/30.

Online Curriculum Designer (1 FTE):

Creates detailed, engaging curriculum and quality resources; collaborates with teachers and the leadership team on curricula; and aligns learning objectives to content and assessments. Closes 5/30.

Online Instructional Coach (1 FTE):

Works with colleagues to incorporate best practices and data to inform and guide instructional decisions, academic feedback, targeted interventions, relationship, and engagement strategies. Closes 6/4.
