ND K-12 Students

NDCDE is a DPI-approved school, providing core, elective, and CTE courses. It served over 5900 ND students in the 21-23 biennium.

Out-of-State K-12

Students

To provide low-cost virtual education to ND students, NDCDE relies on out-of-state enrollments as a subsidy. In 21-23, it educated 725 out-of-state students.

ND Teachers

NDCDE provides professional development, mentoring, and TFFR benefits to all our teachers, and most part-time teachers also work full-time for ND schools.

A member of the Virtual Learning Leadership Alliance and Digital Learning Collaborative, NDCDE shares its best practices to improve virtual education nationally.

ND K-12 Schools

NDCDE offers an extensive menu of low-cost courses otherwise unavailable in rural schools and fills local teacher shortages with our virtual NDlicensed instructors.

ND Higher Education

NDCDE offers dual credit courses in partnership with state colleges/universities, helping to encourage matriculation to an ND higher ed institution.



WHAT WE'RE PROUD OF

Cognia Accredited

As a Cognia-accredited school, NDCDE adheres to high standards for quality education delivery and student-centered operations—the same standards used to measure the quality of traditional ND schools.

Enrollment Growth

NDCDE has seen a 15.4% increase in ND enrollments from the 19-21 to 21-23 biennium. This pattern continues today, with NDCDE currently educating the highest number of learners in its history.

Competency-Based Education (CBE)

NDCDE is transitioning to CBE to evaluate our students, providing targeted feedback on their growth based on state standards. It will be one of the only virtual schools in the country to use CBE.

WHAT WE DO



Elementary Education

NDCDE offers an online elementary program, complete with core subjects, PE, art, and technology courses.



Middle School Education

NDCDE offers over 40 middle school courses, including all core subjects and electives in music, art, and cybersecurity.



HS Core Courses & Diplomas

NDCDE offers all required subjects needed to meet state graduation requirements and awards diplomas to homeschooled students.



HS Electives & CTE Courses

NDCDE helps high school students become choice-ready by offering electives such as foreign language and many CTE courses.



Course Hosting

Through its learning management system, NDCDE hosts drivers' education and one regional CTE Center's courses, helping support local efforts to deliver this critical education.



Filling Teacher Shortages

NDCDE offers temporary assistance to local schools needing to fill a teaching vacancy by providing an ND-licensed virtual teacher to serve as the teacher of record.

HOW WE MEASURE SUCCESS

Completion Rates

NDCDE tracks the percentage of students who completed a course and passed, using these data to inform quality improvements in teaching and student support services. NDCDE's student completion rate for the 21-23 biennium was 78%.

Student Outcomes

In 21-23, NDCDE used student grades to measure student learning gains in its courses, with over 41% of students earning an "A." In 23-25, NDCDE will begin to use data on student proficiency in state standards to comprehensively monitor student learning.

Instructional Quality

NDCDE uses student course evaluations and a comprehensive teacher goalsetting, observation, and evaluation cycle to ensure our teachers deliver high-quality online instruction. In 21-23, on average, 62.5% of students strongly agreed that their instructors were knowledgeable in their content area.

Responsive Support

The NDCDE IT and LMS support teams assist students and teachers with using NDCDE's online technology through an online ticket system. Most tickets are resolved within 24 hours. Response rates and ticket volumes are regularly monitored to assess the quality of support.
